Subject: California Proposition 65

With refer to the “*Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act*” of 1986, also known as “*California Proposition 65*”, the State of California has issued a list of substances that can cause generic mutations, cancer or other reproductive harm.

The list of the substances is yearly updated and is available at the following link:

This measure aims to protect the human health with regard to a potential exposure at these substances.

“California proposition 65” does not impose any quantitative limits about the concentrations of these chemicals, but it is mandatory to indicate their presence in articles or mixtures, if present.

Therefore, we declare, that except for the Lead added in the brass alloys in relation to the indications reported in the European product standards (UNI EN 12164 and UNI EN 12165), that none of the substances indicated in “California Proposition 65 list” is added to the production process.
